Every year Episco-Build has taken part in the Walk for Housing event raising money to build houses, revitalize neighborhoods and enable dreams to come true for hard working families in the city of Newburgh. We have paid for and worked on 5 of the 50 houses completed in the past 10 years. As soon as the 5th house is totally paid for (see the box) we will aim for Episco-Build #6.

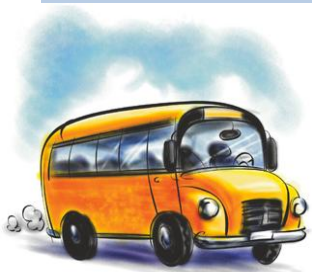

VOLUNTEER—HOW ABOUT A PARISH WORK DAY!

Arranging a Saturday or Wednesday workday is as easy as calling Caitlyn Dalton at the HHGN office at (845) 568-6035, ext. 100. Caitlyn will put you on the calendar and one week before your scheduled workday, she will call you with your work assignment and site number. The size of your group needs to be between one and twelve volunteers. Youth under 18 yrs old can not work on a construction site. Your workday will begin at 8 am on site and end at 1 pm. There is a morning break at 10 am at Calvary Presbyterian Church. No tools or experience needed.
