Lesson: The Golden Calf

Group Lesson

Are there still idols today? The children learned that just as there were idols during the time of Moses, there are still things that try to steal our devotion today. And just like the Israelites, we have to make a choice.



The Israelites grew impatient when Moses took a long time to return from Mt. Sinai. Rather than turning to God, who had miraculously delivered & provided for them, they erected a golden idol to worship as a god. When Moses returned, he became furious and destroyed the idol, but still prayed on their behalf. The people learned that only God deserves our worship.

Response classes

PreK-K Class

Pam brought in golden, homemade play-dough and had the children create a calf. Then they tore it down. The kids loved mashing it to pieces. They then were given dough to take home.

Primary Class

The kids reviewed the 10 commandments by acting out and guessing each one. If you asked one of **Joanna's** students to list the commandments, they may do better than the adults. They may even know the order numbers.

Intermediate Class

The kids discussed the difference between Moses and Aaron. **Kristen** reminded them that every day we can choose to stand up for what's right (Moses) or be swept along with the crowd (Aaron). The choice is ours. They then created boxes to hold some special verses.
