## **Lesson: The Building of the Tabernacle**



*What are you good at doing? What talents has God given you? The children learned that God gave everyone gifts and they can use these special skills to serve his people.*

After the Israelites worshipped the golden calf and then destroyed it, God wanted them to build a Tabernacle – a place that would remind them that God was always with them.

The Tabernacle was a layered, beautiful tent-like structure built by the donations and handiwork of the people. Just like the Israelites, we can all serve God by donating our talents, skills and gifts to his service to create something extraordinary.

In class, the kids experienced the Tabernacle by building the outer court with the benches and they pitched a small tent for the inner court. **Pam** then placed the 10 Commandment tablets in the inner court.



## **Response classes**

### *PreK-K-Early Primary Class*

The children built their version of the Tabernacle by piling up chairs and using blankets. **Pam** invited them to sit in it and they read through the 10 commandments (which were originally kept in the inner court of the Tabernacle).



### *Late Primary/Intermediate Class*

The children brainstormed ways to use their talents for God as they created a knot-quilt. When the quilt is completed the class will donate it to a needy child.
